DRAFT ANNUAL REPORT 2019/20

- 1. The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 states that policing bodies (in this case Police and Crime Commissioners) must produce an annual report that sets out the exercise of the body's functions in each financial year, and the progress which has been made in meeting the objectives set out in the Police and Crime Plan.
- 2. This annual report covers the financial year 2019/20, and demonstrates key activity undertaken by the PCC, the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner, the police, and partners towards meeting the outcomes and priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan 2016-21.
- 3. This is a draft of the report; we will publish a styled version in due course. In the meantime, there is an opportunity for the Police and Crime Panel and other partners to comment on the content.
- 4. This report takes the same format as previous years, with a chapter covering each of the Police & Crime Plan outcomes, illustrated with case studies of OPCC and partnership achievements. Reflecting the unprecedented events of 2020, this edition of the report has an additional section which describes some of the work which has taken place between March and June in response to the immediate challenges of the Covid pandemic.
- 5. We have tried to simplify this year's report by focussing on key achievements which will be of interest to the public and partner agencies. As a consequence, in some cases we have directed the reader to extra information which can be found on our website.
