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1. Summary

- 1.1 Through the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011, the West Yorkshire Police and Crime Panel has a duty to record and consider non-criminal complaints made against the Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) for West Yorkshire and his Deputy.
- 1.2 The table below provides an update on a complaint that is currently being dealt with by the Panel.

- 1.3 The Police and Crime Panel Officer has provided advice to a number of members of the public on the process for dealing with complaints about the Force, the Chief Constable and the Commissioner.
- 1.4 No further complaints have been recorded since the last oral report to Panel on 16th December 2016.
