DRAFT ANNUAL REPORT 2016/17

- 1. The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 states that policing bodies (in this case Police and Crime Commissioners) must produce an annual report that sets out the exercise of the body's functions in each financial year, and the progress which has been made in meeting the objectives set out in the Police and Crime Plan.
- 2. This annual report covers the financial year for 2016/17 (April 2016 to March 2017), and demonstrates key activity undertaken by the PCC, the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner, and police and partners towards meeting the outcomes and priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan 2016-21.
- 3. The report follows a similar format to the previous one which was well received. It is aligned to the outcomes and priorities in the Police and Crime Plan, and provides an overview of some of the progress made towards achieving these. It is not an exhaustive list of our activities.
- 4. This is a draft of the report; we will publish a styled version in due course. In the meantime, there is an opportunity for the Police and Crime Panel and other partners to comment and for amendments to be made.
