Police and Crime Plan Priorities

Link Panel Member Roles

The Police and Crime Commissioner has set out his vision for keeping West Yorkshire safe and feeling safe in his five year Police and Crime Plan. The plan outlines what outcomes the PCC aims to achieve and also sets out his key priorities. A key requirement of the Panel is to support and scrutinise the PCC's Police and crime plan and how the PCC is ensuring delivery of his plan.

It has been agreed that each Panel member should take the role of 'Link Panel member' for a specific priority to enable a more thorough understanding of the involvement of the PCC and the work that is being undertaken to deliver on that priority area. Link Panel members will be matched with a corresponding 'Link Officer' who takes the OPCC lead on that priority area.

As a minimum it would be expected that:

- The OPCC Link Officer should include the Link Panel member on the mailing list for the specific priority areas to ensure they are kept informed of latest developments and to ensure that they receive invitations to all relevant meetings. It would not be expected that the Panel Link member attends all meetings but that they have an understanding of what is planned and is being delivered.
- The Panel Link member is expected to develop a relationship with the OPCC Link Officer and should have at least two meetings per year with them to ensure that they are kept informed of the latest developments on the priority area and how the PCC is delivering on the outcomes in his Police and Crime Plan.
- Panel Link members should liaise where possible directly with other partners within the priority network to seek feedback on the role of the PCC and OPCC to gain a wider overview of the effectiveness of the PCC's interventions on the specific priority area.
- The Link Panel member will be required to feed to the Chair/Panel on their specific priority area.

The Police and Crime Panel officer will help with facilitation of meetings and support some work around the priority plans.
