## **ANNUAL REPORT 2016/17 UPDATE**

- 1. The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 states that policing bodies (in this case Police and Crime Commissioners) must produce an annual report that sets out the exercise of the body's functions in each financial year, and the progress which has been made in meeting the objectives set out in the Police and Crime Plan.
- 2. This annual report covers the period from April 2016 to March 2017, and demonstrates key activity undertaken by the PCC, the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner, and police and partners towards meeting the outcomes and priorities set out in the Police and Crime Plan 2016-21, as refreshed in December 2016.
- 3. The report covers the financial year as required, this does include a slight overlap as the previous annual report covered an 18 month period due to the PCC elections. Due to the breadth of work and progress made by the OPCC, there will be no repetition of content as this annual report will draw on different examples of delivery.
- 4. This report will present performance figures against the outcomes, priorities and measures in the new police and crime plan, for the 12 months to March 2017.
- 5. The first draft of the report is currently being written and will be shared with the Police and Crime panel and other partners in due course for the opportunity to provide input and comment on the style and content of the report before its release which is scheduled for September 2017.
